- The only national organization dedicated to advancing and protecting the interests of the physical therapy profession and its practitioners
 - APTA's goal is to foster advancements in physical therapy practice, research, and education

who then elect

15 individuals to the Board of Directors, which includes APTA's president

ADVOCACY

- Student loan repayment
- Permanent repeal of Medicare cap
- Physician-owned PT services (POPTS)
- Direct access under Medicare



ADVOCACY



- PT-PAC: Raised more than \$1.9 million for the 2007 – 2008 election cycle.
 - gave more than \$1.3 million to candidates running for Congress that supported the views of the physical therapy profession.
- PT-PAC ranks 2nd among non-physician federal PACs
- "PTeam" grassroots network—more than 15,000 PTs, PTAs, & students



ADVOCACY

- APTA coordinated successful grassroots efforts that persuaded legislators to pass HR 6331 in July 2008
- Achieved Passage of the Higher Education Opportunity Act / College Opportunity and Affordability Act (HR 4137)



PAYMENT POLICY

- Constant contact with insurers and payers
- National Insurer Forum with over 100 payers in attendance each year
- National coding workshops
- Reimbursement seminars for members





PUBLIC RELATIONS

- "Move Forward" branding campaign positioning PTs as the movement experts
- Work with members of the news media on behalf of physical therapists and physical therapist assistants


